

Billing Information for Financial Aid

Your financial aid award will be prepared once financial aid has received your budget.

If recipient of Vassar scholarship, funds will be credited to student's account the first week of July for fall term, first week of December for spring term.

Federal aid, loans and grants as well as international loans are disbursed in two equal payments and will credit the student's account 10 days prior to start of Vassar classes for both fall and spring terms *provided* all financial aid requirements have been met..

Domestic programs: No bill is sent from Vassar for study away program with the exception of the *Venture Urban Education Semester*. * Student and family responsible for paying domestic program direct for all program costs. Any credit balance on student account from financial aid credits will be sent home unless other arrangements made with Student Accounts.

**Venture Urban Education Semester. Vassar College will bill the student for Venture's tuition and room charge. Students are responsible to pay all other expenses direct to program.*

Vassar based/Vassar consortium programs:

Vassar-Wesleyan in Madrid (at Carlos III University)

This includes one round-trip plane ticket to Spain. The comprehensive fee will be REDUCED by the airfare price for those students who make their own travel arrangements to and from Spain. This comprehensive fee includes the Santiago orientation (if undertaken in the fall) and the Granada orientation (if undertaken in the spring), tuition, room and board, airfare and excursions.

Vassar-Wesleyan Program in PARIS

This fee is NOT comprehensive. It includes orientation in Bordeaux for fall and spring terms, ,tuition, airfare (NY-Paris, air flight or bus to Bordeaux), and excursions. Room and board is not included. Students make arrangements for room and board on an individual basis with the help of the program. They must pay a refundable security deposit and rent directly to their landlord or landlady.

ECCO--Vassar-Wesleyan-Wellesley in BOLOGNA

This is a comprehensive fee including the Lecce orientation if undertaken in the fall, tuition, room and board (a 2/3 meal allowance/stipend), visa, airfare (NY-Brindisi (via Rome or Milan) return to NY) and excursions. It does not include the one week break between the Lecce orientation program and the start of classes in Bologna for the fall term.

Vassar Program in MOROCCO (MOR) in conjunction with AmidEasat

This is a comprehensive fee including tuition, room and board, airfare, and excursions.

Irish Internship in Galway for Elementary and Secondary directed by Brendan Flynn

This is not a comprehensive fee. It includes tuition, orientation and room and board. It does NOT include airfare.

BERLIN Consortium (Administered by Columbia University)

As Associate members of the Berlin Consortium we charge Vassar tuition. This fee does NOT include airfare, room or board. Students deal directly with Columbia for payment of room and board.

Vassar ST. PETERSBURG Program at European University (Classes taught at the Hermitage)

Fees are comprehensive—includes tuition, room/board, roundtrip airfare, excursions and visa invitation letter. Students must obtain their visa individually.

Financial aid will be used to pay balance due to Student Accounts. Any credit balance remaining will be sent home unless other arrangements made by family with Student Accounts. Student and family responsible for paying any costs not billed by Vassar. Non-Vassar based overseas programs:

Student will be billed for Vassar College tuition. Vassar College will pay program/university tuition fee. Student will be responsible for room/board, airfare and any other miscellaneous expenses. Financial aid will be used first to pay balance due to Student Accounts. Any credit balance remaining will be sent home unless other arrangements made by the family with Student Accounts. Deposits:

Study abroad program deposits are not advanced by financial aid. However, the deposit is included as part of the cost of the approved budget upon which your financial need is determined.

NB: if student owes a balance from prior semester, financial aid will be used to satisfy balance owed to Student Accounts before issuing any credit refund check.

Insurance:

All students will be charged Vassar insurance. If the student has comparable coverage, they will receive information to waive the insurance online.
